MSAN Professional Learning

The Minority Student Achievement Network (MSAN) is a national coalition of multiracial public school districts working together to understand and eliminate racial opportunity/achievement gaps that persist in schools. To advance this shared mission, MSAN districts engage in collaborative research, share promising practices, and invest in professional learning. MSAN's Professional Learning agenda has three anchors: Communities of Practice, Conferences, and Online Resources.



Community of Practice Meetings - MSAN itself is one large community of practice; smaller groups, also called communities of practice, meet face to face and virtually throughout the year, and have access to optional projects and interactions between meetings. Ad hoc leadership groups are also sometimes mobilized around specific issues, projects, and events.

MSAN coordinates three primary communities of practice:

- Superintendents of MSAN member districts (also known as the MSAN Governing Board),
- MSAN Research-Practitioner Council (district staff designated by MSAN superintendents), and
- MSAN Student Leaders and their Allies ("allies" include MSAN Student Conference chaperones and others designated by districts to engage in activities at the student conference and during the year)

Conferences - MSAN hosts two annual conferences:

- The MSAN Student Conference is a gathering of high school student leaders from MSAN member districts. Along with adult allies from their schools, delegates to the conference engage in discussions about equity in their districts and develop plans of action to share with decision makers in their districts.
- The MSAN Institute is a two-day intensive professional learning opportunity focused on sharing cutting-edge strategies for building leadership for equity and advancing culturally responsive practices. At the Institute, participants explore current research and promising practices with local and national experts, engage in district planning and job-alike conversations, and hear from students most affected by equity issues.

Online Resources - The MSAN website consists of a set of electronic resources on research, strategies, programs, and policies to assist school districts in eliminating racial barriers to student success. Resources include:

- Webpages created by members of the Research-Practitioner Council, that provide links to resources on the eight MSAN research and development areas;
- Links to videos and resources from past MSAN conferences and research presentations (MSAN Members Only);
- MSAN Research Briefs outlining research-based strategies and interventions for improving outcomes for students from underserved groups (MSAN Members Only)
- Demographic data on MSAN districts (MSAN Members Only)
- Enhanced search for members, including access to MSAN's Clearinghouse of Promising Practices (MSAN Members Only)
